## Quiz 2 Ditloids.

Today's Quiz is another based on Ditloids: as per last week this is a puzzle in which a phrase, quotation, date or fact must be deduced by use of the numbers and the first letters of key words given in the clue. Also known as Language Equations the name derives from 1 DITLOID which is 1 Day in the Life of Ivan Denisovich (written by Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn).

For example the answer to 1 W on a U would be 1 Wheel on a Unicycle, or 1969 CFF is 1969 Concorde's First Flight.
