
## U3A Quiz (40): "It ended in Tiers"

38. An American Country singer and songwriter elected to the country Music Hall of Fame in 2013. His hits include "Coward of the County", "Lucille" and "The Gambler".
39. An American World War Two flying ace who later, as a Test pilot, was the first person to break the Sound Barrier.
40. An English Actor and Comedian probably best known as one of "The Goodies" and as a regular panellist on "I'm sorry I haven't a clue".
41. An Argentinian professional footballer and manager rated as one of the best players of all time although the English remember him for his use of a hand!
42. An Australian-American singer, songwriter and actress, whose 1970's hit "I am a Woman" now has iconic status.
