Please find attached the answers to Monday's **Words** Quiz: I hope the extra day was of use and you managed to get most if not all of the answers.

Just a couple of quick comments and explanations on a few of the clues/answers:

Q13 The French Four referred to The Three Musketeers but there were (in essence anyway) four of them so I was looking for their motto.

Q14 was not a Football question as some of you might thought as Football Club would have filled the criteria: Man Utd were founded in 1878 and the upstarts (Man City) two years later. The Halle Orchestra was the answer I was looking for.

Q21: Charles lost his head here refers to the execution of Charles I : I was looking for Whitehall Palace but as a number of sources place it as being outside the Banqueting Hall this also fits the criteria so either answer will do.

Q30: The Gareth in question was the character he played in "Four Weddings and a Funeral" and he is also known for his depictions of Charles Dickens, the answer being Simon Callow (but of course you worked that out!)

Q33: this refers to the character Wally in a widely published "game" where you have to spot him in a picture or setting so the answer I was looking for was "Where's Wally?" although Wally will suffice.

Q34: The same actor - Timothy Spall - played both people in films, although I only knew of him as having played Turner (see how I'm educating you and myself at the same time?)

Q43: I added in Gibraltar and Amsterdam at the last moment which hopefully made it easier but this is a reference to a popular song sung by none other then the Beatles and refers to John Lennon and Yoko Ono's Honeymoon, both Gibraltar and Amsterdam being mentioned in the lyrics. the answer was "The Ballad of John and Yoko".

Q44: Hopefully you all know the song which is an old English Folk Song but came to greater prominence as a hit by Steel Eye Span, the answer being "All Around My Hat".

I hope the rest of the answers were self-explanatory.

Anyway after that it's back to a straightforward general Knowledge Quiz which is also attached - answers tomorrow with the next Themed Quiz.
