

**MEDLEY: Side by side; Show me the way to go home;
Roll out the barrel; Knees up Mother Brown**

Oh we (C) ain't got a barrel of (F) mo(C)ney
(C) Maybe we're ragged and (F) fun(C)ny
(C) But we'll (F) travel along, (C) singin' a (A7) song
(D7) Side {G7} by (C) side

(C) Don't know what's coming to (F) mo(C) row
(C) Maybe it's trouble and (F) sor(C)row
But we'll (F) travel the road, (C) sharin' our (A7) load, (D7)
Side (G7) by (C) side

(E7) Through all kinds of weather, (A7) what if the sky should fall?
As (D7) long as we're together, it (G7) really doesn't matter at all.

When they've (C) all had their troubles and (F) par(C)ted
(C) We'll be the same as we (F) star(C)ted
Just (F) trav'lin' along (C) singin' a (A7) song
(D7) Side (G7) by {C} side

Straight on to:

*(C) Show me the way to go home
I'm (F) tired and I want to go to (C) bed.
I had a little drink about an hour ago
And it's {G7} gone right to my head.
No (C) matter where I roam
On (F) land or sea or (E7) foam
You will (C) always hear me singing this song
(G7) Show me the way to go (C) home.

REPEAT from "Show me the way to go home

Then straight on to Roll out the Barrel:

*(C) Roll out the barrel, we'll have a barrel of (G7) fun
Roll out the barrel, we've got the blues on the (C) run
Zing! Boom ta-ra-rel, sing out a song of good (F) cheer (A7)
(Dm) now's the time to (G7) roll the (C) barrel
For the (D7) gang's (G7) all (C) here.

REPEAT from ""Roll out the barrel Then

straight on to:

*** (C) Knees up Mother Brown
(F) Knees up Mother Brown
(G7) Under the table you must go
Ee-aye, Ee-aye, Ee-aye-oh
(C) If I catch you bending
I'll (F) saw your legs right off
(G7) Knees up, Knees up, don't get the breeze up
(G7) Knees up Mother (C) Brown

(C) Oh my, (F) what a rotten song (G7)
What a rotten song
(F) What a rotten (C) song
'C) Oh my, (F) what a rotten song
And (G7) what a rotten singer (
C) Too-oo-oo

REPEAT from ***Knees up Mother Brown
