

Members' Code of Conduct

Watford Park u3a (WPu3a) members are expected to conduct themselves in line with the u3a Movement's Guiding Principles. They are also expected to treat each other with dignity and respect. Specifically:

- Members are expected to know, follow and promote the Principles of the u3a Movement at every opportunity. These can be found on the u3a website (<u>https://www.u3a.org.uk/?view=article&id=312&catid=163</u>)
- Members must always act in the best interests of WPu3a and the u3a Movement, strive to uphold its reputation and never do anything which could bring their own u3a, another u3a, or the u3a Movement into disrepute or expose it to undue risk.
- Members are expected to use WPu3a's resources responsibly and only to further its stated charitable objectives/purposes.
- Members are expected to reflect the current organisational policy of WPu3a, regardless of whether it conflicts with their personal views.
- Members are expected to know and abide by WPu3a's policies, procedures and practices. These can be found on the WPu3a website under Documents/WPU3A Documents.
- Members are expected to treat each other with dignity and respect at all times.
